On behalf of the 550 residents of Beaver Island, I'd like to extend a hearty 'thank you.' Your wireless solution to the public-address needs of our annual 4th of July celebration sent this quaint little township rocketing into the 21st century!

Our 6- by 13-mile little rock juts out of northern Lake Michigan and is home to an additional 1500 residents during the summer months. A favorite getaway spot, we welcome another 1500 to 2000 vacationers every year. Many come to enjoy our 4th of July parade, which includes a 35-piece marching band, floats, and a tribute to islanders who have served and died in the Civil War through the Korean War. This reading is a moving aspect of the day's program, though not easily heard throughout the township. Thus, one of our seasonal residents decided it was time to acquire a sound system up to the challenge.

Through his efforts, Beaver Island raised enough money to purchase from Listen Technologies a wireless sound system. The very fact that we went wireless made organizers nearly giddy: no more time-gobbling setup and breakdown involving myriad cables! Your stationary transmitter and receivers, along with a rack-mount kit, complemented by JBL speakers, an Audio Technicia wireless microphone and a Shure mixer, got the sound job done - and more. This multifunction base station (with a four-channel mixer and a five-disk CD changer) enabled us to provide soft background music throughout the day, while an outdoor wall socket allowed musicians to plug into the system directly from their sound mixer.

With a base station installed in the Chamber of Commerce building and receivers and speakers located throughout the community, the sound was amazing. (I must admit, though, the weather didn't cooperate - it rained on our parade)! The reading of the vet's names was more moving than ever. So much so, you could hear a pin drop (or in this case, soft rain falling). All in all, we had an unforgettable 4th of July.

We may be quaint and tiny as communities go, but we are a close-knit township, whose citizens enjoy coming together to celebrate holidays and special events throughout the year.
